Mr. Britt is a limnologist and certified Virginia Master Naturalist with more than 40 years of professional experience in the fields of restoration ecology, conservation biology, and environmental management. He has served as senior executive officer for four professional service organizations where he was responsible for day to day operations, strategic corporate planning, policy development, and profit and loss. Mr. Britt has managed large, interdisciplinary science and technology programs for many federal agencies having scientific missions, including: BLM, CEQ, EPA, FDA, FWS, DOE, NASA, NIH, NOAA, NPS and USGS. He has authored peer-reviewed scientific publications and provided expert testimony to a U.S. Senate Subcommittee on Energy and the Environment and at Maryland state rule-making hearings.

Since retiring in 2015, Mr. Britt has participated in several environmental projects and programs in Fairfax County. He served on the Fairfax County Community-wide Energy and Climate Action Plan (CECAP) Task Force. He currently serves as Chairman of Reston Association's Environmental Advisory Committee (EAC) where he also serves as Project Lead and Technical Editor for the Reston Association State of the Environment Report (RASER). He was instrumental in establishing the first Reston BioBlitz which was conducted in 2018. He currently participates in Reston Association's Volunteer Stream Monitoring Program as well as the Chesapeake Bay Alliance and Isaac Walton League stream monitoring programs. In 2018 he supported Reston Association by drafting a successful application making Reston the 13th international community to be accepted into the Biophilic Cities Network. In 2019 he was appointed to the Reston Association Board of Directors as an At-Large-Director. Currently he serves on the Board of Rescue Reston which was established to help prevent the future development of Reston's golf courses.
